General Conditions 2011

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

We will confirm receipt of the online registration form within 3 days. The registration form must be received no later than Friday, June 10, 2011.

The registration form must be accompanied by the deposit required for the number of weeks of participation in the immersion program (see registration fees below). The amount must be in Canadian dollars and is payable to CADFEL, the non-profit organization that administers the *Académie des langues de Trois-Pistoles*. This deposit is deductible from the total cost of admission to the program but does not include any bank charges on money transfers. Shortly after receipt of the registration and deposit, the *Académie des langues* will confirm the participant's admission in writing.

Canadian citizens may send a regular cheque by mail. Please be sure to indicate the name of the student and the dates of participation. Outside of Canada, we recommend this payment be made by international credit transfer. Ask us for bank details. To avoid double bank charges, you can make one payment in full.

REGISTRATION FEES

\$100 deposit for one week (remaining balance \$469)

\$200 deposit for two weeks (remaining balance \$938)

\$300 deposit for three weeks (remaining balance \$1,407)

The remaining balance (in Canadian dollars) must be received by the *Académie des langues* by Friday, June 24, 2011, at the latest (by cheque for Canadians or by international credit transfer).

MEDICAL CARE

Participants must arrange for accident and health insurance to cover their stay in Quebec before leaving their country or even another Canadian province.

REFUND POLICY

- Deposit fees are non-refundable at any time.
- If a student withdraws eight to thirty (8 to 30) days before the program start date, 50 % of the total cost will be charged to the student.
- If a student withdraws seven (7) days or less before the program start date, there will be no refund.
- If a student withdraws after the beginning of the program, there will be no refund.

We strongly recommend getting cancellation insurance to avoid those charges.

VISA

Participants from most European countries and the Americas are not usually required to obtain a visa if the period of study amounts to less than ninety (90) days. Participation in this program is usually considered as tourism. Nonetheless, if you are not a resident of North America, we recommend that you contact a Canadian Embassy or Canadian Consulate to confirm your visa status. You may be asked to show your letter of admission to an immigration agent when you arrive in Canada (<http://www.cic.gc.ca/english/visit/index.html>).

RESPONSABILITY

The *Académie des langues de Trois-Pistoles* ensures that the students' safety will be the primary concern during their stay, but cannot be held responsible, in any way, for any type of loss, damage, injury or expense that may result from participation in the program. Students must comply with the rules of the camp. Failure to do so may result in the student's dismissal. The Director the camp, Louis-Marie Bédard and the Director of the *Académie*, Patricia Trinquet, must both receive a written description of any complaints.

An interview and placement test will determine the level of study for each student before the program begins.
